Our team is experienced with liaising with parents and can help ease the liaison load between schools students and parents. We have a lot of experience with mental health, behavioural and complex SEN needs.



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


Quality Assurance

Recent School Feedback


Did you notice an improved confidence in the children attending sessions?




Did the children use any skills/knowledge learned in sessions in class?
